## Notice of Special Resolution

At the Annual General Meeting, members will vote on an amendment to the DRBIPA Bylaws:

CURRENT BYLAW:

22 (1). The board of directors shall, in the notice to members of the annual general meeting, list its nominations to fill the vacancies on the board of directors. Such nominations shall represent a broad spectrum of users and user groups of the parks.

AMENDED BYLAW:

22 (1). Each year, a Nominating Committee will request, receive and evaluate nominations and will submit a list of recommended nominees for election at the annual general meeting. Nominations must be received no less than 14 days before the annual general meeting.

Reason for amendment: DRBIPA has implemented a process to assess board candidates. The process ensures candidates are aligned with the objectives of DRBIPA.
